## Attendance



Regular attendance at school is essential.

High expectations are placed upon students to be punctual. This prepares them for the future.

We ask that you, as parents, work with us to ensure your child attends school. We take pride in our excellent attendance figures.

Certificates are awarded termly to students who gain 100% attendance.

Our attendance is well above the National Average because parents and students realise the value of attending school.

We work closely with the Education Welfare Service to support any student who falls below 95% attendance.

## Anti-Bullying

Greenfield Community College seeks to provide a safe, secure and positive environment in which all children and adults can develop and grow, making full use of the range of facilities available to them. Everyone is entitled to be treated with respect and understanding and be able to participate in any activity free from intimidation.

In Greenfield we actively listen to all students and act on any information received.

We take all forms of bullying seriously, including cyber bullying, racism, homophobia and sexual discrimination and we have clear procedures to address this through our anti-bullying policy.

# Special Educational Needs and Disability (SEND)

**Every student is entitled to achieve to their potential.**

Greenfield is an inclusive school and we try to match the curriculum to meet the child's individual needs. A SEND Support Plan and Outcome Review Record is personalised to the child. This ensures a greater understanding of each individual child and how they learn best.

All of this information is reviewed, updated regularly and overseen by the SEND Coordinator.

The SEND Co-ordinator is available at all Year 6 events and throughout your child's time at our school to answer questions and ensure their needs are met.

Interventions are tailored to meet your child's needs and help them to gain confidence in numeracy and literacy.

The school works closely with primary schools to ensure a smooth transition to Greenfield.

As students progress through the school, their assessments are used to determine their teaching group for academic subjects.

The setting of the students and results from the testing allow teachers to plan differentiated learning opportunities and curriculum.

Above all, we listen to parents to ensure every child receives the support they need.

## Safety

Student safety is of paramount importance at Greenfield.

We have invested a lot of time and funding in making sure the site is safe in all areas. We have addressed issues with the traffic system and work closely with the police to make sure our children can arrive and leave the site safely.

We have a pass system at lunchtime and encourage parents to advise their children that they should stay on the school site, to take advantage of the excellent, nutritious options available from our catering services.

Security fences and gates have timers attached and are in place to prevent unwanted visitors entering the site. All staff are trained to at least level 1 in Safeguarding and have appropriate pre-employment checks carried out before they are allowed to work with our students.
