- A strong working knowledge of safeguarding, behaviour and attendance;
- Experience of successfully working with vulnerable people and those with special educational needs;
- A strong commitment and ability to work with external agencies and the wider community;
- An ability to problem solve, make quick decisions and work successfully under pressure in a fast-moving but rewarding environment.
